


#### Instructions:


**Installing #1 Steel curved (quilters) or straight safety pins:** Press coil end of pin into the hole and hold in place with thumb and index finger, use pliers to snap pin wire (in the center) into the cover (See Fig. 1). Then use pliers to snap coil into hole (See Fig. 2).


**NOTE**: Quilters Pins (curved pins) are very easy to install. Pins from different manufactures can vary in wire diameter. If a pin comes loose, use pliers to crimp the plastic over the wire, this "locks" the pin (See Fig. 3 & 4).
